

BREDON WARD PROFILE STATISTICS: BASED ON ONS 2011 DATA EXTRACTED FROM WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY LOCAL AREA PROFILE

Population by Age

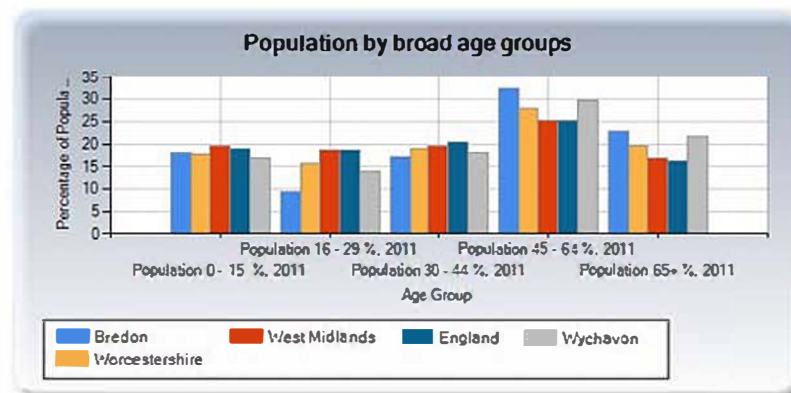
In Bredon 18.0% of the population are aged under 16 compared to 17.7% in Worcestershire, and 18.9% in England.
 The population aged between 16-64 in Bredon make up 59.2% of the total population, this compares with 62.8% in Worcestershire.
 Individuals aged over 65 years make up 22.8% of the total population in Bredon compared to 19.5% in Worcestershire, and 16.4% in England.

In general Worcestershire has an older age profile than is seen across the whole of England. The 30-44 age group in England accounts for 20.6% of the total population, compared to 19.1% of the total population in Worcestershire, and 17.1% in Bredon. In contrast, the 65+ age group accounts for 16.4% of the total population in England, compared to 19.5% of the population in Worcestershire, and 22.8% in Bredon.
