Grit Bins

After the recent snowfall in the Parish, it was noted that some of the local pavements were slippery and dangerous.

Therefore, we have agreed to purchase three salt bins and a tonne of salt, each bin holds 1/3 tonne.

Over the next few meetings we will discuss the best locations for these bins. Obviously we cannot cover all pavements in the Parish, so will prioritise these bins on a number of factors i.e. access to public buildings.

Road Closure in Bredon's Norton

Temporary Closure Order: to close that part of U46203 Manor Lane, Bredon's Norton from its junction with U46205 The Lane to its junction with U46206 Lampitt Lane in order to facilitate gas works by Wales & West Utilities .

Exemptions: to permit access to any land or premises fronting the highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to allow the works to be undertaken.

Alternative route: U46201 Manor Lane and vice versa.
Anticipated duration: **2 days** Commencing: **9 April 2018**.

Telephone Kiosks Update

The Parish Council has officially adopted three of our Parish telephone kiosks: Kinsham, Westmancote and Queensmead. We are in the process of adopting the last decommissioned telephone kiosk in Bredon's Norton. Note : This kiosk in Bredon's Norton is Grade 2 listed.

Once all four Telephone Kiosks have been adopted, we will initiate a Project regarding the restoration and future use of these kiosks. Ideas have included fitting defibrillators or using as a free library.
