## Precept 2018-19

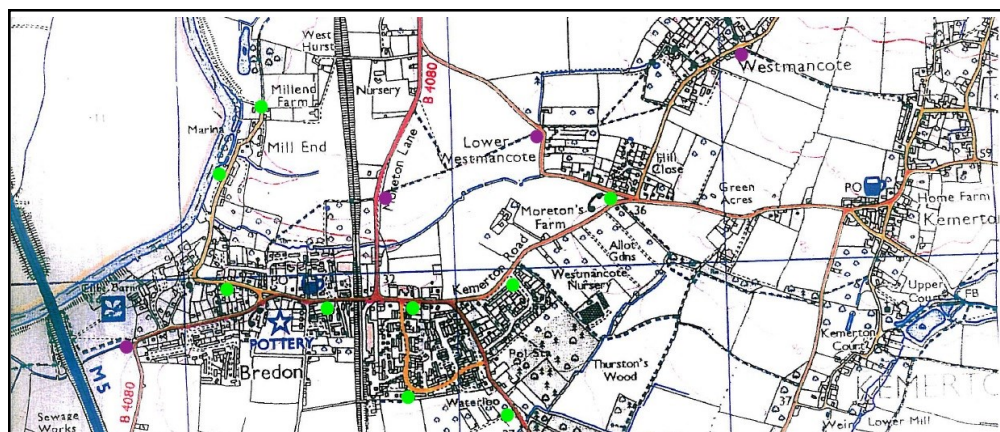
The Finance Committee has aimed, as in recent years, to keep the cost per household frozen for another year. It is a complex calculation, involving a number of factors, which alter every year, making it difficult to match last year's council tax exactly. If you do notice a change it should only be minimal.

## New Dog Waste Bins

There have been a number of complaints regarding dog walkers leaving dog waste on frequently used footpaths around the Parish. Some analysis of the routes dog walkers tend to use was gathered by a member of the Council. The Council voted on the proposal of 4 new dog waste bins, and it received a majority vote. These bins cost money to install and get emptied on a regular basis, so please make sure they are used.

**W/17/02488/HP** - St Catherine's Barn, Lampitt Lane, Bredons Norton. Replacement single storey building for annexe accommodation, garaging and store facilities associated with existing dwelling. PC has made general comments.

**W/17/02192/HP** - Blackberry Barn, Manor Lane, Bredons Norton. Garden room extension to rear of dwelling & conversion of existing garage to a bedroom, ensuite & wc. Refurbishment & replanning of existing ground floor layout to provide a 2nd additional bedroom. Landscaping works to front & rear gardens including new driveway to rear. Changes to fenestration to north & south elevations. PC objects to the proposal.

**W/17/02524/HP and W/17/02525/LB** - Greenhayes, Farm Lane, Westmancote. Proposed outbuilding incorporating storage, home office & triple garage within the curtilage of a listed building & Westmancote Conservation Area. PC objects to the proposal.

**W/17/02551/HP** - 4 Cotswold Close, Bredon. Single storey extension at rear. PC has made general comments.
