W/18/00931 - The Nook, Chapel Lane, Westmancote. Works to convert existing ancillary building to residential annex (granny annex). PC has no objections.

W/18/00950 - The Coach House, Back Lane, Bredon. Attached domestic parent annexe as approved under planning permission, but without compliance with condition 3 (so as to allow property to be used as a separate dwelling). PC objects.

W/18/00691 - Malvern View, Rectory Farm Lane, Bredons Norton. Construction of new dwelling and alteration to existing access on garden land to side Malvern View Bredon Norton. PC objects

W/18/00792 - The Milk Barn, Rectory Lane, Bredons Hardwick. Planning approval W/15/00381/PP to change gable roof to gambrel roof to create second storey storage area above workshop. Changes to length and width of the workshop and alteration to windows. PC has no objections.

W/18/00924 - P And D Engineering, Fleet Lane, Bredon. New showroom, first floor offices and meeting room, workshop extension, and covered store building as approved under planning permission reference number W/12/00412/PN - but not in accordance with Condition 5 (to amend the external materials to be used in construction). PC has no objections.

W/18/00775 - Ashley Cottage, Cheltenham Road, Kinsham. Side extension incorporating a double garage in the ground floor level and a new bedroom in the first floor level including demolition of existing garage. Erection of new vehicular and pedestrian gates. PC has no objections.
