## New fencing by playing field entrance

The Council is submitting a few applications for 106 monies which needs to be spent before February 2019, one of these is improved fencing around the entrances to the playing fields.

We are currently looking into various materials and designs, but we are hoping to make the entrances safer, with improved signage, and generally making the entrances from the car parks more pleasant.

## Lengthsman Vacancy

There is currently a vacancy for a Parish Lengthsman. The role would include:

- Drainage Maintenance;
- Vegetation Clearance;
- Litter picking, weeding and clearing areas of the parish;
- Maintaining benches;
- Rotation and charging of Vehicle Activate signs;
- Regular inspections of defibrillators;
- Additional duties as and when required.

Hours: Flexible working for 7-8 hours per week, at £11 per hour.
