## **Traffic Group meeting**



We have held 4 sessions at Bredon Village Hall and 1 in Bredon's Norton Village Hall. Thank you again for all the volunteers who helped give up their time to hand out, and register, the Smartwater kits.

The police are really pleased with the success of the project, and have agreed to give us some signs (see example), so we can start placing signage around the parish. We are planning to position the signs at the entrances to all the villages within our parish, hopefully deterring criminals from targeting our parish.
