## **Police Report**

On the 16/10 we received a report that a vehicle had been stolen from Kinsham. The owner managed to follow the vehicle and it was abandoned nearby. Enquiries are still ongoing.

A burglary was reported at The Dell on the 19/10. Access was gained from the rear of the property and items of jewellery and cash stolen.

A green Subaru was stolen from a farm on Bredon Road, Tewkesbury and was reported on the 23/10 though could have been stolen some days previously.

Two reports received of theft of tools from works vans one on 26/10 in Bredon and the second from Kinsham on 01/11. One of the vehicles had been left insecure.

On the 26/10 a strimmer was stolen from Main Road, Westmancote and damage caused to a caravan.

A trailer was stolen on the 03/11 from Bredon's Norton. It has since been recovered along with a stolen vehicle and someone is currently being dealt with for the offence.

We have received an email from the Tewkesbury SNT warning us that there have been a number of burglaries in the Gloucestershire area near to our border.

- 3 new salt bins will be installed by the Village Hall, near the Jubilee car park and on the triangle opposite the telephone kiosk near Farm Lane.
