## Improvements around the Parish

The Parish Council has been working hard to maintain and improve the facilities around the parish.

- A new bench has been installed by the obelisk.
- The hedge in front of Bredon Hill Surgery, where someone drove through, is going to be replaced.
- We have received our Smartwater signage, which should deter criminals, and these will be positioned around the parish in the near future.
- We successfully received some grant money to improve the village hall. We apologise for the disruption and any inconvenience this causes, whilst building work takes place.

## Refrain from parking on Footpaths

On a number of occasions recently, vehicles have been parking by the entrance to the South car park (opposite the bowling club) and blocking the footpath - see images below, the red circle marking the area in question.

This footpath is used frequently by the elderly, disabled and parents with pushchairs. When it is blocked by a vehicle, the pedestrians face a dangerous route into the road to circumnavigate the vehicle. Please can people not park here in the future.



## Police Report

We have had 3 crimes reported in Bredon during May 2019:-

On 2<sup>nd</sup> we received a report of a burglary which took place at a property on Main Road, Bredon. Two males were seen driving a Ford Transit Van appearing like they were looking for scrap. They have been seen by a witness kicking a door down & damaging it, then entered a farm building & stole some tractor weights, then got back into the vehicle & made off.

On 8<sup>th</sup> we received a report of a theft from a motor vehicle which took place at Pippins Road, Bredon. Tools were taken from the van - Honda Generator, Dewalt Power Saw, battery saw, battery drills x 2 and copper cable. All these items were about 10 years old. A specialist piece of equipment was stolen called a carbon sniffer. Total amount approx. £2500. Van is owned by Western Power Distribution who have been informed.

On 24<sup>th</sup> we received a report of Interference with a motor vehicle which took place at a property on Queensmead, Bredon, whilst the owner was away on a week's holiday, Person(s) unknown have caused damage to the rear doors of a White Peugeot panel van. Entry gained. Nothing stolen.
