Community Legacy Grant

The Parish Council submitted an expression of interest (stage one application) for a Wychavon Community Legacy Grant. The application was based on providing better connectivity between the Parish villages, without the need to utilise motor transport. Our application has been successful in progressing through to stage 2, so the Council are now in the process of preparing the full application.

As part of stage 2, the Council will be engaging with Parishioners to seek their thoughts on the project, to assess the level of need and support. The Parish Council invites Parishioners to make recommendations and show their support for this project to the Parish Council, so these can be accounted for in the stage 2 submission to the District Council.

Natural Networks Project

The Parish Council has successfully applied for a grant from the European Regional Development Fund, delivered in partnership with Worcestershire County Council and Worcestershire Wildlife Trust. We are currently seeking more funds, but look for temporary signs going up at Glebe Field and the wooded corner of the playing field, with the stream.

Some of the initial project work will commence in these areas, with help from the school, BCPR, and other local organisations. Please respect any areas where planting has taken place, or construction started.
