We just need to pray the seeds grow and we can begin weeding. If this initial area proves successful then we will be extending again in the future. Don't worry if you missed out, there will be plenty of opportunities to volunteer your services. We are also planning some tree planting around the parish, and a clear up of the brook in the corner of the playing field.
