As there has been an increase in flash flooding in recent years, both the council and District Councillor Adrian Hardman are keeping a close eye on various areas of the parish.

- Bredons Norton's "Duck Pond" is still an issue, and work they did last year still hasn't solved the problem, so further investigations required.
- Cheynes Corner, Bredon is still getting blocked, but once the County Council sucker has visited it is easily cleared.
- The previous problems in Kinsham and Queensmead seem to have been resolved, but we will still keep an eye on them.
- Westmancote still isn't resolved and requires a longer term solution.

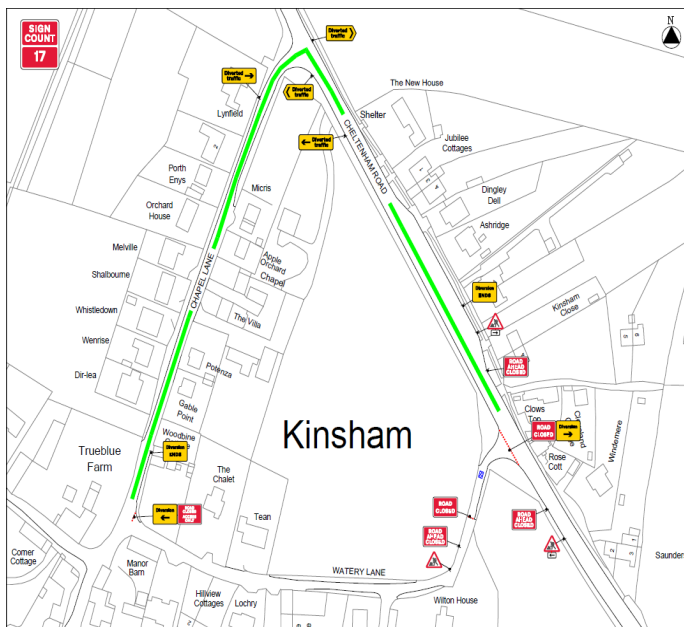
Ultrafast Full Fibre

Watery Lane, Kinsham - Road Closure

Reason for restriction:- To lay new ducting. There is a need to close the highway in the following terms:-
