Ashchurch Bridge Judicial Review

An appeal has been agreed with both Northway and Ashchurch Parish Councils. The legal team believes that we have a strong case to appeal the Judicial Review. They believe that the judge should not have looked at the bridge as an isolated case, but should have looked at the bigger picture. Bredon Parish Council will continue to strive, on behalf of its parishioners, to take all reasonable steps to prevent the harms arising from the 'Bridge to Nowhere' application.

Mitton Bank Update - Traffic Report ignored

A copy of a comprehensive traffic report from an independent expert (Railton) was sent to all parties involved in the planning decisions. National Highways had originally put their own block on the sites development since 2017, but responded to the excellent independent report with comments like "Nothing to see here". We will be writing back to them with many points highlighted, asking them to engage more meaningfully with the serious issues raised. Mitton Bank is the first of many phases of Tewkesbury Garden Town's 10,000 houses to be built. We are also asking our MP, the Right Honourable Harriet Baldwin, to listen to us. Please feel free to write to your MP highlighting your concerns about future development in Mitton Bank.

New Bredon Village Hall Website


The Village Hall website has recently been refreshed and upgraded. It now has an embedded, online, hall booking system called Hallmaster. Once a user registers they can book any spare time slot at any of the halls. The Hallmaster calendar shows all booked events, and when they are due to happen. This helps any viewer decide if they might like to join an event by contacting the group leader via the contact information on the 'Regular Users' page, which shows all the group contacts with their website links. The new booking system also has the added advantage that anyone wishing to book a future private event can go on the website and book. 
