



SafeAvon project

A representative from 'SafeAvon' gave a presentation at the Parish Council meeting on 12th August 2024.

SafeAvon are a volunteer organisation testing and monitoring water quality in the local area in and around the Avon, from North Stratford to Tewkesbury. They sample water along this route and keen to enlist more volunteers

The group have asked that the parish council consider contributing to this work by buying a testing kit for volunteers to use. The council will consider this proposal at it's September meeting.

We will also be considering inviting speakers from SafeAvon to a community meeting later in the year.

Malthouse Lane

Permission has been granted by Worcestershire county council for the resurfacing of the footpath at Malthouse Lane, Bredon.

This long awaited work is proposed to start on 30/10/24 and is due to finish on 1/11/24.

There will be some inconvenience while the work is being completed however, resurfacing this pedestrian section should render the pathway safer and give greater ease of access

More upgrades to the village hall

The gent's toilets in Bredon village hall will be getting a face lift. The parish council agreed to replace the sinks and taps, make good the tiling and seal the flooring. This should make the sinks safer for children to use and bring the toilets up to a more acceptable standard.

Glebe Field wildflower update

On the weekend of the 21st and 22nd September 2024, we are extending the successful wildflower meadow to hopefully cover more of the field.

We are hiring a digger and dumper truck, which will be driven by qualified volunteer drivers, so you may notice work being carried out over this weekend.

Don't worry, they will just be removing the turf, and a few inches of topsoil so the ground is less fertile, giving the wildflower seeds the best chance of establishing in the soil.
